

University of Calgary in Qatar (UCQ) management calls upon all members of the community to take care and apply simple, preventive measures to protect against infection. These measures apply to students, faculty, staff, contractors, and visitors:

- Facemasks are mandatory throughout the UCQ campus (including outdoors).
- Maintain social distancing
- Wash your hands often or using hand sanitizers
- Avoid physical contact, including shaking hands
- Use your sleeve to cover your nose and mouth when coughing and sneezing or use tissue paper and dispose of it appropriately.
- Take the COVID-19 vaccine and the booster shot as soon as you can do so and/or qualify.

COVID-19 Positive Case: Faculty, or staff who tests positive for COVID-19 must contact their manager/supervisor and notify OHS specialist within 24 hours of receiving their result. If the individual has been in the building within the last 3 days, the Contact Tracing form will be completed as required by the MOPH and anyone who has been in contact with the individual will be notified. Disinfection of all impacted spaces and surfaces will be performed.

Students who tested positive for COVID-19 should:

- inform your instructor and email Ms. Norane in Student Services: norane.osman@ucalgary.edu.qa
- If you are not feeling well or were in contact with someone who tested positive, please don't come to campus,

Faculty and staff who tested positive for COVID-19 should:

- not enter the campus. Inform your manager/supervisor, that you cannot report to work on campus and provide, any documents, you have on hand (i.e. EHTERAZ, test result, etc.)

The infected person must do the following:

- Inform and send a copy of the test result and or a copy of the quarantine undertaking to your manager/ supervisor
- The infected person is obliged to complete the quarantine period as determined by the health authorities and to fully comply with the instructions issued by the Ministry of Public Health (MOPH). Follow home quarantine guide issued by the MOPH
- After the specified quarantine period is completed, the infected student or staff returns to study or work as normal.
- **Only the infected person with a reactive result has to perform a second test six (6) days after the first one.**

COVID-19 GUIDANCE FOR POSITIVE AND CLOSE CONTACTS

SCENARIO 1:

You tested reactive/positive for COVID-19 by PCR or RAT.

Regardless of your vaccination status and regardless whether or not you have symptoms

Must STAY HOME and notify your Manager/Supervisor and Email screen shot of your EHTEAZ to CP: tahir.farooqui@ucalgary.ca

Do not come to work until EHTEAZ is GREEN

Your manager or Tahir will contact you for contact tracing if you have been on-campus in the last 3 days

SCENARIO 2:

You were in close contact with an individual who tested positive for COVID-19. (Note: you can take Rapid Antigen Test anytime and watch for symptoms)

Are you fully vaccinated – with a third dose or with a 2nd dose vaccine done within the last 4 months? (also under the age of 50)

YES

Do you have symptoms?

YES

STAY HOME and NOTIFY your Manager/Supervisor & CP

GET TESTED IMMEDIATELY.

Rapid Antigen Testing done at PHCC or in an approved private health center/clinic

POSITIVE

Follow Scenario 1

NO

Take self Rapid antigen Test

NEGATIVE

You can return to work

NO

STAY HOME and NOTIFY your Manager/Supervisor

GET TESTED IMMEDIATELY.

Take a PCR test and wait for your result

POSITIVE

Follow Scenario 1

NEGATIVE

You can return to work

Scenario 3:

You have symptom(s) of COVID-19 but NO known exposure to a COVID-19 positive individual

STAY HOME.

Do not go to work and/or class regardless of vaccination status

GET TESTED IMMEDIATELY.

POSITIVE

Follow Scenario 1

NEGATIVE

You can return to work

Do you have ongoing close contacts (e.g. household member(s) with COVID-19)?

YES

Do not come to campus until contact ceased and you are tested negative before returning to campus. Contact MOPH Hotline: 16000 for any questions

NO

No further actions needed.

Please do not come to campus if you have symptoms even if you are tested negative. Contact your manager/supervisor or Tahir for any questions.
