

# TUITION INFORMATION

There are three academic terms (Fall, Winter, Spring) in each academic year. The Bachelor of Nursing Regular Track Program is generally completed in four years.

Each 3 credit costs QR 1,500 and each student generally takes 30 credits per year with total tuition costing QR 15,000.

The Tuition example below is for one year of study in the Regular Track Bachelor of Nursing Program

Bachelor of Nursing Full-Time Students Example of one term of study Fall term	
Tuition for 4 (3 credit) courses	QR 6,000

Bachelor of Nursing Full-Time Students Example of one term of study Winter term	
Tuition for 4 (3 credit) courses	QR 6,000

Bachelor of Nursing Full-Time Students Example of Spring term of study	
Tuition for 2 (3 credit) courses	QR 3,000

Once in the Nursing program your tuition will be based on how many courses you are taking each term and how many credits each of those courses is worth. Students usually take the credit equivalent of four courses in fall and winter terms and two courses in spring term. There can be exceptions for a variety of reasons. This is meant as an example for you. You may find your course load and therefore total tuition is different.

Some courses may count for credit for 2 or more courses. You will be charged cost based on the number of credits the course is valued at. (Example: if one course is 6 credits it will cost 3,000 QAR)

Note: Qatari passport holders are exempted from undergraduate tuition for their first attempt of a course. Should the student be required to repeat the course, either due to unsatisfactory grades or a course withdrawal, the student shall be assessed Qatar Resident fees for subsequent course attempts.
